As a result of these shifting practices, physicians / pediatricians / surgeons / medical officers working in settings such as private offices and clinics may be faced with potential, or real, pediatric emergencies. These caregivers and emergency medicine practitioners can benefit immensely from this conference. This conference envisages delivering a practical approach and recommendations on treatment in many critical areas of your practice in handling such patients and helps you in decision making and delivering safe care.
